

**PUBLIC UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 1 OF COWLITZ COUNTY, WASHINGTON**

**SCHEDULE 10 - PRIVATE STREET AND AREA LIGHTING**

**APPLICABILITY**

Applicable to street, roadway, and area lighting not installed or supplied by a governmental subdivision.

**CHARACTER OF SERVICE**

Secondary voltage; single-phase, or three-phase as available.

**MONTHLY RATE**

A flat rate per lighting unit as follows:

Sodium Vapor 100 watts, 8,550 Lumen	\$ 6.85
Sodium Vapor 200 watts, 19,800 Lumen	\$ 11.30

**SPECIAL CONDITIONS**

All lighting equipment, including mast arms, brackets, control equipment, transformers, wiring and supports, shall be owned, operated and maintained by the District.

For new installations which do not utilize an existing District-owned pole and require the setting of a new pole for the light, the customer shall pay in advance \$300 as an Aid-to-Construction.

The District will require a Special Contract for service hereunder for a term of not less than sixty (60) consecutive months reflecting monthly payments computed in accordance with this Rate Schedule as it may be amended or superseded.
